

## ANNUPUR

### \*(484) SHIV TEMPLE, DHARHAR



It can be reached by *pucca* and mud road situated at a distance of 8kms from Pusprajgarh. The Shiv temple is in the forest about 2 kms away from the Dharhar village.

This temple is built of black stones. The upper portion of the temple is ruined and the remains are lying nearby. It probably belongs to the 10-11<sup>th</sup> century. There is a *bawadi* built of black stones near the temple in which there is water round the year.

### \*(485) TEMPLE OF ROHANIJI, AMARKANTAK



Situated at a distance of 68kms from Anuppur, this temple is built of bricks, stones and lime powder. There is *mandap* and *garbha-griha*, the *mandapa* rests on two *pillars* and the wall and Nandi is situated on the *mandapa*. The walls of the temple are plain on which the terraces have been extended with ramparts. The *shikhar* is constructed in trirath style. There are *aamalak*, *sarikaghat*, a series of *kalash* and *beejpurak* over it. The temple seems to have been built in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.
